POSITION SUMMARY:

Community Health Promoters (CHPs) educate their communities about LGBTQ health-related and social justice topics through peer-to-peer conversations and larger scale community presentations. CHPs take on leadership roles within the group and may assist with program recruitment, planning, and implementation. CHPs are also be invited to represent the program or D&R at special events.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- Demonstrates a commitment to the program values of equity, inclusion, action, and leadership.
- Learns about healthy relationships, substance use harm reduction, and sexual health topics aimed at reducing LGBTQ health disparities.
- Shares information about the above listed subjects with peers and work as an activist for positive change within your community.
- Attends and participates in bi-monthly CHP meetings.
- Participates in outreach events and CHP retreats.
- Contributes to program planning and facilitation.
- Documents community conversations and other program participation.
- Maintains confidentiality about program participant data.

- Willingness to develop and move toward personal or professional goals related to program objectives.
